Working Hard, Working Smart

Guest of Honour, 2nd Annual Graduation

Ecclesiastes 9:10, Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.

In my view, Working Smart means,

1. Know - Without Christ we can do nothing.

Without Christ, you can do nothing. Just what does this mean exactly? Without Jesus we can do nothing of eternal significance." We are powerless without Christ to build eternal things; we are spiritually poor and without power outside of Christ! But with Christ we are rich in every way, we now have the power to affect eternal things and leave a legacy that will impact eternity and last into eternity.

As you graduate: The Bible teaches us that only by dwelling in Christ and His love do we have eternal significance and can reap eternal rewards. Without Christ, we can do nothing of eternal significance!

2. Recognize – We have a purpose in life so don't live a goal-less life.

In 1953 researchers polled the graduating class of [Yale University](#) and found that 3% of the graduates practiced goal setting and had a set of clearly defined written goals. In 1973, researchers went back and visited the class of '53 and found that the 3% of the graduates who had the clear and written goals had amassed a fortune worth more than the other 97% combined.

Students: God has given you gifts and abilities. The calling of God is irrevocable, Romans 11:29. Be transformed by the renewal of your mind – read good books and the Bible; associate with Godly agenda. Surrender, sacrifice and set daily, monthly and annual goals.

3. Make wise choices, i.e. have wisdom.

A famous author gives us 10 ways to walk in wisdom including these two.

I. Pay attention to what wise people do and

say. Incline your ear and hear the words of the wise and apply your heart to my my knowledge Pro 22:17. Do you have uncles or aunties, or church members that you have always admired their character and career progression? Visit them – now or when in campus to ask for advice . Some of you in the next few years may be making decisions about a marriage.

II. Seek God's wisdom, not the world's.

Do not make your decision based on some actions from a movie made from Nollywood or Hollywood. *Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?* 1 Corinthians 1:20

3. We are in the Bitcoin Age, 5G etc.

As you exit high school, go to campus, get a local or international job, what should you look for much, much more? Mind these two items: KOG and FOG- Knowledge of God and Fear of God.

My son, if you receive my words and treasure my commands within you, so that you incline your ear to wisdom and apply your heart to understanding ... then you will understand the fear of God and find the knowledge of God. Proverbs 2:1-5

4. Get rid of negative emotions.

Refuse to be anxious about anything knowing that God is in control of your life. Refuse to be controlled by anger. It causes you to do things that you may later regret.

5. Choose and plan to be in the G group.

Giraffes (see ahead; represent the wealthy) and Zebras (survive in a group; stay near water; represent the rich)

My prayer for you is that you will not be a rich Christian, but a wealthy Christian, so that you can bless others with your resources and leave a legacy.
